Sow: Amaranth, Artichoke, Beet-root, Broccoli, Broad beans, Cabbage, Calendula, Carrot, Cauli-flower, Chervil, Cleome, Coriander, Florence Fennel, Kale (also Cavolo Nero, Borekale), Kale, Kohlrabi, Leeks and winter lettuces. NZ Spinach, Onion, Parsley, Parsnip, Peas, Phacelia, Radish, Silverbeet, Spinach, Turnip, Viola

Plant: seedlings of most of the above for an earlier crop. Also Beans, Burdock, Cape gooseberry, Chicory, Chives, Dill, Lavender, Marigold, Marjoram, Okra, Oregano, Potato, Rocket, Sage, Sorrel, Yarrow.

Harvest: Continue to pick summer crops such as tomatoes, eggplant, zucchini. Remember the more chillies you pick, the more will grow!

Save seed: Remember, seed saved from F1 hybrids may not come true to type.
