Sow

Vegetables:

Beetroot, broad beans, brussels sprouts, cabbage family (cabbage, cauliflower, collards, kale, mizuna, mustard, pak choi) carrot, celery, corn salad, garlic, leeks, lettuce, onion, pea and snow peas, radish, silverbeet and spinach, turnips.

Herbs

Chives, Coriander, Cress, Oregano and Marjoram, Mint, Parsley, Rocket

Flowers

Calendula, Cornflower, some Poppies, Phacelia, Violas and Pansies

Harvest

Autumn fruit and berries. Jerusalem artichokes, kumara. Lettuce, edible flowers

Collect seed

Most spent annuals and summer flowering perennials will now have seedheads - collect seeds from basil, chives, calendula, cardoon, dahlia, anise hyssop, rosehips, zinnia etc.
